DISBUDDING

The use of disbudding/dehorning paste (caustic) is not permitted on organic holdings, the only method of disbudding/dehorning permitted by the DAFM is hot iron cautery and Anaesthesia and/or Analgesia must be used in all cases.

Dehorning of livestock over 6 months of age, regardless of the reason or person carrying out the procedure, will result in the loss of organic status of the animal.

Invoices/receipts from the Veterinarian for supply and/or use of the Anaesthesia and/or Analgesia must be available for inspection. Not using Anaesthesia and/or Analgesia will result in non-compliances being issued and possible financial penalties being applied by DAFM.
