This form must be completed, signed and details retained in the Record Book if non-organic stock are used to graze organic or in-conversion land during the calendar year.

Please refer to section 3.03 of the Organic Food and Farming Standards in Ireland Edition 2 (hereafter referred to as the Standards).

Non-organic livestock can use, for a limited period per calendar year, the pasturage of organic units provided that:

- The grazing is for pasture management or disease control purposes;
- The total period does not exceed 180 days per calendar year;
- Such animals come from farming systems as defined in paragraph 3.03.13 of the Standards;
- Organic animals of the same species are not present on any part of the pasturage at the same time;
- Withdrawal periods for medications are observed as specified in 3.12.13 and 3.12.14 the Standards;

In addition the following conditions must be complied with:

- Such animals must be treated as specified in the Standards whilst they remain on the land;
- Such animals and their by-products may not be sold as organic;
- Animals grazing organic/in-conversion land may not be fed any feedstuffs possibly containing genetically modified organisms or derivatives thereof whilst grazing this land.
